7. Both parties shall continue to notify the local child support agency of any change of address within 10 business days of that change. The parent ordered to pay support shall also notify the local child support agency and the payee of any change of employment and any substantial change in the amount of his or her income, including receipt of bonus compensation, such that his or her ability to pay child support or family support is affected. Notification of any substantial change in the amount of the payer's income will not result in a change of the order unless a revision of the order is sought.
